## WHAT IS INSTITUTIONAL DATA

Institutional data refers to all information that is created, collected, licensed, maintained, recorded, used, or managed by [an institution], its employees, and agents working on its behalf, regardless of ownership or origin.

#### AND DATA...

is substantive and relevant to the planning, managing, operating, documenting, staffing, or auditing of one or more major administrative functions, or multiple organizational units, of the [institution].

#### WHY USE DATA?


